



IUD INSTRUCTIONS

- Placement of an IUD is usually done while you have your period.
- IUD's are inserted during the menstrual cycle preferably during bright red bleeding. This insures that the patient is not pregnant and also makes insertion a little easier since the cervix is slightly dilated. Insertion can be done up to day 7 of your cycle.
- **Post partum:** IUD's *will not* be inserted before 8 weeks post partum. Dr. Block prefers 12 weeks post partum. If the patient is not getting her menses, she must abstain from intercourse for 14 days and then return to the clinic for a pregnancy test. If the pregnancy test is negative, the IUD will be inserted.

Please contact your insurance and be aware of your IUD benefits prior to scheduling your appointment.
